What is the Seal of Biliteracy?

The Seal of Biliteracy is a seal placed on a student's transcript by the state of Utah. This seal represents that students have demonstrated proficiency in both English and a World Language.

Who can apply for the Seal of Biliteracy?

All juniors (early application) and Seniors with language proficiency in both English and a World Language may apply for the seal. They will need to take the AAPPL (The ACTFL Assessment of Performance toward Proficiency in Languages) exam to assess adequate language proficiency.

How can students apply for the Seal of Biliteracy?

The application will be available in the Counseling Center from Jan 31st to March 3rd. Students need to pay the school's financial secretary for each AAPPL test needed (See application). Students can then take their receipt along with their application to the counseling office for submission. The front office is the only location money will be accepted.

What is the testing window?

Students must complete all testing between March 27th -March 31st. Individual schools will determine the date, time and location of testing.
