ANIMATION

DIGITAL PAINTING WITH THE IPAD

Paint on an iPad without ever having to clean a brush (iPads provided).

DOCUMENTARY

Explore cinéma vérité documentary film production techniques.

FASHION DESIGN - HAIR FASCINATORS

Design a trendy fascinator that can be worn on many occasions.

FASHION DESIGN - DRAPING

Explore the art of fashion draping and learn industry techniques to transform a plain piece of cloth into an inspired sculptural design by making a draped project on a dress form.

FIGURE DRAWING

Learn basic figure drawing skills while drawing in charcoal from a live, costumed model.

FILM COMBAT

Safely and effectively perform believable cinematic violence.

FOLEY

Add sound effects to film in the college's advanced recording studio.

HEAD PAINTING

Work with oil to paint a live model.

MOBILE APP PUBLISHING

Publish a mobile app by making a game that uses audio, gyroscope and obstacles on iPads.

MOVEMENT EXPLORATION

Learn contemporary and jazz dance techniques and choreography along with elements of improvisation.

NEWS REPORTING THROUGH INSTAGRAM

Learn the basics of the news story and how to package that information into a compelling and engaging Instagram story.

ON-AIR RADIO PRODUCTION

Master the techniques and craft of being a live on-air radio DJ.

PHOTOGRAMS

Learn to create stunning images in the darkroom without even using a camera.

POST-PRODUCTION

Learn the steps of digital post-production special effects work and compositing using Adobe After Effects.

PRINTMAKING

Produce a collaborative "Exquisite Corpse" Monotype print. Plates will be made with Plexiglas using ink and paintbrushes; prints will be made on the college's new etching press.

SLOW MOTION FILMMAKING

Learn slow motion filmmaking tips and techniques while shooting with a Red Camera.

STUDIO PHOTOGRAPHY

Step into the glamorized world of professional photography and explore creative studio lighting for producing exceptional portraits.

TV STUDIO PRODUCTION

Bring a TV show to life in the Center for Arts & Media's state-of-the-art TV broadcast studio.
