- Our **Class of 2018 Graduation ceremony** will be held on **Tuesday, June 5<sup>th</sup>** at the University of Utah, Huntsman Center at 10:00am.
- **Parents of Seniors!** Please be aware that in order to be on track for graduation, you must comply with the following date:
  - **May 31<sup>st</sup> ("D day"):** Seniors must be passing all **current classes, online coursework**, and have all **NGs** made up. If not, counselors will let parents know their student is in jeopardy of not graduating.
- Seniors – remember to order your final transcripts to be sent to **Regents Scholarship** and your college of choice. You can order them by coming into the Registrar's office or on the Alta website. Transcripts will be mailed mid-June.
