



ALTA PARKING REGULATIONS and CONTRACT

There are approximately 750 parking stalls at Alta High School. Therefore, parking on Alta campus is a privilege – not a right. Parking regulations must be observed by all who park on campus in order to provide for safe and efficient traffic control. Students must park in designated parking areas. Students who park in areas not designated for student parking will be fined. Students and parents must sign a parking contract that will be included in this packet before you can purchase a parking permit. Violations of the parking contract may result in one of these consequences: 1) a parking citation, 2) booting of the vehicle, 3) towing at the owner's expense. **These areas of violations include faculty areas, visitor area, handicapped area, red zones, and unmarked areas.** Sandy City Police parking tickets may be issued for vehicles parked illegally on campus as well.

ALL PARKING CITATIONS MUST BE PAID BY THE END OF EACH SEMESTER OR THE STUDENT PARKING PASS WILL BE REVOKED.

The shortage of parking spaces at Alta High is a problem. For this reason, only **Juniors** and **Seniors** are allowed to park in student parking areas. Sophomores and Freshmen parking on campus will be fined and repeat offenders may lose their parking privileges for future years. Unfortunately, even with prohibited sophomore and freshman parking there is a shortage of parking spaces. **Due to limited parking, a parking permit does not guarantee an available parking space.** Consequently, students parking on campus during regular school hours are on a first-come, first-serve basis and all vehicles must be removed from the Drivers Ed. Range by 3:00 p.m., or they will be subject to immediate towing at owners expense. **Each student is allowed one parking permit only!** For extenuating circumstances see parking administrator.

We strongly urge students to car pool and ride busses when provided and to also be dropped off by parents. Students leaving campus for off-site classes may find it difficult to locate a parking spot upon returning. The shortage of parking spaces is **not** a valid excuse to park illegally. Off-campus parking may need to be pre-planned.

Juniors and seniors desiring to park a vehicle on campus during the school day must sign a contract and purchase a Alta High parking permit. It must be properly displayed in the vehicle. Students parking on campus without displaying a current parking permit will be fined. Parking permits cost \$10.00. When the need arises, current parking stickers may be replaced without cost by surrendering the previously issued sticker to the parking administrator. Parking permits are **not transferable** either to another student or to another vehicle. Parking stickers must be permanently affixed in the lower corner of the front window on the driver's side of the vehicle.

For juniors and seniors, a permit application is provided below. Permit applications will also be available in the main office. Students may purchase a parking permit and turn in the form in the main office. For emergency purposes, temporary passes may be obtained, for \$1, from the main office throughout the school year. Students are only allowed three temporary passes throughout the school year.

I understand parking my vehicle at Alta High School is a privilege which can be revoked if I disobey school, local, municipal, and state laws. To retain and maintain my parking privileges I specifically understand the following:

1. Only **JUNIORS** and **SENIORS** are eligible to purchase parking permits. A senior or junior may purchase one parking permit for their personal use. For extenuating circumstances see parking administrator. If a student purchases a parking permit in behalf of another student, the purchaser and the recipient will be subject to disciplinary action.
2. **ALL PARKING CITATIONS MUST BE PAID BY THE END OF EACH SEMESTER OR THE STUDENT PARKING PASS WILL BE REVOKED.** A first ticket carries a fine of \$15.00. This can be reduced to \$10.00 if paid within 10 school days. Each subsequent ticket carries a fine of \$20.00. This can be reduced to \$15.00 if paid within 10 days. A boot will put on your vehicle after 5 tickets. A first boot carries a fine of \$50.00 with no reduction. Towing fees are determined by the Towing Agency.
3. Any student parking in a faculty-parking stall or in a visitor stall is subject to a citation, booting, and/or towing at owner's expense. Students may only park in designated student parking areas. **THIS CONTRACT SERVES AS THE FIRST AND ONLY WARNING A STUDENT WILL RECEIVE FOR PARKING VIOLATIONS.**
4. A parking permit may be purchased from the Main Office. The parking decal must be firmly affixed (not taped) to the lower left-hand corner of the front windshield on the driver's side. If the decal is improperly displayed, a citation may be issued.
5. All vehicles must be properly registered and maintained at all times in accordance with state laws.
6. It is illegal for any vehicle to obtain/contain illicit drugs, stolen property, etc., while parked on school property or at school activities. Never, under any circumstances, should any type of weapon be in a vehicle while parked at Alta High School or at a school related activity. A person who violates the District Policy faces possible expulsion from school for up to 180 days.
7. School officials have jurisdiction over any vehicle while it is on school property and have the right to search a vehicle and the right, within state and federal laws, to seize improper materials found in any vehicle.
8. Students may park on the Driver's Education range provided they remove their vehicles by 3:00 p.m. each school day. If the vehicle is not removed, it is subject to towing at the owner's expense.
9. **Students who lose their permits will be charged an additional fee to receive a new one. Students who are replacing a windshield will need to bring in the old permit to receive a new one – otherwise they will be charged an additional fee.**
10. Students purchasing a parking permit are not guaranteed a parking stall. The permit does allow a student to legally park in available designated areas on campus. Violation of the parking contract may result in one of these consequences: 1) a \$25.00 parking citation or 2) the vehicle may be booted or towed/impounded at the owner's expense.
11. For emergencies or other mitigating circumstances see the main office for a temporary parking permit for \$1.00. Limit of three per year.
12. Student must present a current vehicle registration and his/her driver's license when purchasing a parking permit.
