Curriculum Pace	Normal pace of curriculum, meeting the standards of CSD curriculum maps.	Normal pace of curriculum, meeting the standards of CSD curriculum maps, which will enable CSD to pivot quickly to online-learning-only if state government and health officials order another closure of Utah schools.	Parents or guardians can help their students learn at the same pace as their peers, allowing for a smooth transition to in-person instruction at a future date.
