- ✓ **Positive Behavior Interventions and Support & SEL curriculum:** Canyons District remains committed to supporting students in building the life skills, or character traits, that contribute to success in life and school. In support of that goal, the Administration is proposing to create a social-emotional learning curriculum developed by in-house instructional experts in alignment with Utah State Board of Education requirements and the community's needs. At the Tuesday, Oct. 5 meeting of the Canyons Board of Education, the Administration will propose a timeline for the development of this curriculum. First prize is 50\$ and a publication; runner up earns 25\$ and a publication. This contest is schoolwide, in collaboration with the school newspaper. Euphony Staff and Journalism students pick the top 4 each semester. The student body then votes for their favorite. The winners of each semester have a run-off. We look forward to your submissions!
- ✓ **Math Club:** For students interested in joining the Math Club, the first meeting is on **Tuesday October 5 at 2:30** in Room 2105 (Ms. Price). The goal of Math Club is to discuss math with peers and to prepare for math competitions. The club looks great on college applications, helps students to qualify for the math cord and increases their chance of earning the Sterling Scholar for math. It also challenges students to expand their mathematical knowledge beyond the topics discussed in class.

2021 PSAT Information

The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test is a great tool for students considering college. The PSAT/NMSQT measures critical reading skills, math problem-solving skills and writing skills. Alta High School recommends that students take the PSAT/NMSQT in order to receive feedback about strengths and weaknesses, enter the competition for National Merit Scholar scholarships (11th graders) and to help prepare for the SAT.

The 2021 PSAT will be administered on Wednesday, October 13 in the Hawk House. Students participating in this exam will be excused from their morning classes.

For the 2021 PSAT/NMSQT, students at Alta High School will be registering online. This registration will take a few minutes and can be completed from any computer with internet access.

Online Exam registration will begin on Mon, Sep 13, 2021 at 7:30 AM and end on Fri, Oct 8, 2021 at 10:00 PM. In order to register, students should click on the link provided on the school website or visit www.TotalRegistration.net/PSAT/450402. To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students have printed the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end.


There are a limited number of tests available, so register before they sell out!

- Wed, October 13, 2021 – PSAT Test in the Hawk House, 7:30 am

With great pleasure, we announce that the Utah Chapter of Freedoms Foundation at Valley Forge will again provide the opportunity for selected **Junior and Senior** students throughout Utah to attend the 2022 *Spirit of America Youth Conference* at Valley Forge, Pennsylvania. Those students selected may attend one of **four** sessions held in March and April of 2022.

Each student will participate in a four-day conference for high school students from across the country to interact with college professors and historical interpreters. The program also includes tours of Valley Forge, Independence Hall, Constitution Center, and the Liberty Bell.

We are excited to announce that we will be offering **100 spots** for students this year, the most we have ever sent! Students will be selected from public, private, and charter high schools from across the state. Your support is crucial to make sure your school is represented. Please make certain all interested 11th & 12th grade students in your school are made aware of this opportunity by furnishing them copies of the attached conference information. You may also wish to make copies available to school counselors and history teachers.

Semi-finalists will be invited to participate in an interview with Freedoms Foundation Board members in Salt Lake City or Gunnison.

Students will be required to pay \$400 of the total estimated cost of \$1,200. The Utah Freedoms Foundation Scholarship Fund will cover the remaining costs of the conference. **Applications must be postmarked no later than Friday, November 19, 2021, and mailed to the address listed on the application.**

Since its founding in 1949, more than two million students have been impacted by the Freedoms Foundation programs. The Freedoms Foundation at Valley Forge is a nonpartisan, nonprofit foundation founded by President Dwight D. Eisenhower.
