

### 2021 PSAT Information

The Preliminary SAT/National Merit Scholarship Qualifying Test is a great tool for students considering college. The PSAT/NMSQT measures critical reading skills, math problem-solving skills and writing skills. Alta High School recommends that students take the PSAT/NMSQT in order to receive feedback about strengths and weaknesses, enter the competition for National Merit Scholar scholarships (11th graders) and to help prepare for the SAT.

The 2021 PSAT will be administered on Wednesday, October 13 in the Hawk House. Students participating in this exam will be excused from their morning classes.

For the 2021 PSAT/NMSQT, students at Alta High School will be registering online. This registration will take a few minutes and can be completed from any computer with internet access.

Online Exam registration will begin on Mon, Sep 13, 2021 at 7:30 AM and end on Fri, Oct 8, 2021 at10:00 PM. In order to register, students should click on the link provided on the school website or visit <a href="https://www.TotalRegistration.net/PSAT/450402">www.TotalRegistration.net/PSAT/450402</a>. To complete registration, students must answer all of the required questions. Registration is not complete until students have printed the pdf of the confirmation page that is provided at the end.

\*There are a limited number of tests available, so register before they sell out!\*

Alta High School is excited to offer families the convenience of paying exam fees online at the time of registration. Please be sure to have a **debit or credit card available before beginning registration**. Paying online is a great way to make sure that payment has been made while avoiding mailing your payment. Here are the important dates for the registration process:

- Mon, Sep 13, 2021 at 7:30 AM Registration Begins
- Wed, Oct 6, 2021 at 10:00 PM Registrations and payments after this date will incur a \$5 late fee .
- Fri, Oct 8, 2021 at 10:00 PM Registration Ends
- Wed, October 13, 2021 PSAT Test in the Hawk House, 7:30 am

Dear AP Students and Parents:

It is already time to register and pay for your 2022 AP exams! As you may recall, College Board, the company over Advanced Placement (AP), is now instituting a FALL exam registration deadline. ALL AP students will need to decide whether or not to take and order their exams by *November 1, 2021 to avoid paying late fees*. Here is a schedule of Alta's registration timeline:

- Registration DEADLINE (to avoid late fees): Monday, November 1st by 10:00 pm.
- Exams ordered after **November 1st** will incur a \$10 late fee per exam.
- Exams ordered after November 8th will incur a \$20 late fee per exam.
- Exams ordered between after November 15th will incur a \$40 late fee per exam.
- Absolutely NO changes can be made to our exam order after March 15, 2022.

It is important to understand that registering and paying for AP exams is a **TWO STEP** process. Shannon Kershaw, Alta's AP Coordinator, has visited all of Alta's AP classes and has walked our AP students through the steps below. At this point, if your student was present for the presentation, the only remaining step is for you to log into the Total Registration site with your child to submit your payment. If your child missed the presentation, the steps are below and Ms. Kershaw's presentation is available on Alta's Counseling website as well as each AP teacher's Canvas page.

- □ Step 1: Students must first log into a third-party site, www.TotalRegistration.net/AP/450402, to pay for their AP exam(s). If your student took AP exams last year, they will already have an existing account. You will need to pay for your exam(s) by November 1, 2021 to avoid late fees. Alta's AP exam fee for the 2021-2022 school year is \$100/exam. Total Registration also provides the opportunity to indicate if you are in the Free/Reduced lunch program and therefore qualify for a fee reduction of \$55 per exam OR if you are requesting financial assistance through Alta, in which case, you must contact Shannon Kershaw to discuss.
  - o At the conclusion of the Total Registration process, students will receive a unique JOIN CODE per AP course/exam for which they register. They will need this information for Step 2.
- □ Step 2: All students must then go online to College Board and either create a new or log into an existing account at *www.collegeboard.org*. They will then enter in the unique JOIN CODE received through Total Registration to gain access to College Board's online resources for that AP subject area. They must also then select the option to "Register for the Exam". This is the only way College Board knows to send Alta an exam for the student to take in May.

Again, please remember that the <u>ONLY WAY</u> to guarantee your child will have an AP exam to take in May of 2022 is to complete <u>BOTH</u> the Total Registration (payment step) and College Board (exam ordering step) by **November 1**<sup>st</sup> to avoid late fees.




