

**Social Studies Honor Cord Application
Alta High School**

**If you qualify for a High Honors cord at Alta High School,
you may NOT apply for the Social Studies Honor cord.**

The ONLY EXCEPTION to this policy is the Social Studies Sterling Scholar.

A completed application consists of this sheet (completely filled out) and an attached transcript (with social studies classes, GPA, and ACT scores highlighted). You must meet ALL five of the following criteria to apply and be approved:

1. Four and a half credits of social studies classes from the list below using one of two possible options:

Option 1: 9th grade full-year World Geography option, 10th grade full-year World Civilizations option, 11th grade full-year U.S. History option, 12th grade semester U.S. Government option, and at least one year or two semesters of social studies elective credit.

Option 2: 9th grade full-year World Geography option, 10th grade full-year World Civilizations option, 11th grade full-year U.S. History option, 12th grade full-year U.S. Government option, and at least one semester of social studies elective credit.

Exceptions can be made to these options through an appeals process if you attended a previous school/district that did not require these options in the same manner or order.

If you are currently enrolled in some of these credits the spring semester of your senior year but meet all other requirements, you will be tentatively approved to receive your cord, subject to meeting the grade requirement by midterm 4th quarter.

2. Must have taken at least 1 full-year advanced/college level (AP) social studies class—

AP Human Geography, AP World History, AP U.S. History, AP U.S. Government and AP Comparative Government, AP European History, and/or AP Psychology.

3. Cumulative Social Studies GPA of 3.6 or higher

4. Cumulative School GPA of 3.0 or higher

5. Composite ACT score of 23 or higher
