  - Needs assessment survey going to parents in near future
  - Two more meetings, one on April 12, and the last meeting of the year will be held on May 9
- IV. Counseling Corner – Mrs. Bjerregaard
  - Counseling Center is finishing course requests. All course requests were done on paper this year instead of on skyward. The Registrar requested it to be done that way. They are wondering if there is any feedback from parents on doing paper verses digitally. It helped counselors see what was missing for each student. Students could also be called down to classes fill in

missing information

- The Counseling Center is considering doing individual PCCRs for 9th graders as well as the 11th graders next year
- Suggestions were made to send out more info about what the PCCRs are so more parents come and to make course request cards more visible on Alta website during course request time of year. Could a training video also be made to explain the process to parents?
