Time: Two sessions will be available if numbers justify. They will be 7:30 a.m. & 10:00 a.m. Class sessions will last about 2&1/2 hours. Numbers justified 2 classes last summer and we anticipate they will this summer as well. There will be a cap of 41 students per class and it will be first come, first serve for registration. #### Registration/Fee:

The driver Education fee covers the cost of the classroom as well as road and range driving. The fee this summer is \$155.00. Non-refundable after 6/4/25.


Registration and fee payment must be completed by the first day of class. Fee payment for Canyons District students can be made with a credit card on Skyward. Out of district students must come into the main office to pay with cash or a check. Also, out of district students will not receive a letter grade, but they can get certified to get a license. Canyons district students will receive a letter grade since they are already in the system. Your class time will be set upon registration. You will not be contacted to confirm your class time unless there is a change. The class fee is nonrefundable after June 9th.

### Requirements to pass the class and receive a completion certificate:

You must have:

27 hours of classroom instruction.

You can only miss 1 classroom session and still complete the 27 hours of in-class instruction that is required by the District/State Board of Education, so plan on being in class each day. One make-up session will be allowed for those students that need to make up an absence. This will be explained in class the first day.



Range times will be held on the same days as the classes and some Fridays and Saturdays. You must have a permit to drive on the range.

3 hours of behind the wheel instruction on the road.

Road times are arranged by and through the road instructor. With your cooperation driving should be completed by the end of the summer school session or by your birthday. You will drive 5 different sessions to complete this phase of the program. You must have a permit to start this phase of the program.

#### 80% class average to pass the class.

You will earn one quarter of elective credit (Canyons District students only) from this class, which will be applied toward graduating from high school. Out of district students can take the class and get a license, but they will not receive school credit since they are not in our district.

#### -earner Permits

Learner Permits can be obtained from the Driver License Division at the age of 15. To receive a permit, you must pass a 50 question test, pay \$19, pass a health questionnaire, pass a vision test, provide your original birth certificate and SS card, and show two forms of ID proving that you reside in Ufah (Prop. Tax Notice, City Bill, Power Bill, etc.). The State of Utah requires hat applicants under the age of 18 have a learner permit for 6 months prior to receiving their driver license. Please do your sest to get a Learners Permit before the first day of class. Permit tests are given during the school year each Tuesday and hursday at Alta at 7:05 AM In the driver education room (1514).

## Advantages of a school program.

- 1. Students will be given the State Road Exam at no extra cost.
- 2. A thorough knowledge of the state laws will be taught as well as defensive driving skills and courtesies of driving.
