


WHAT IS GOOGLE MEET?

- **Google Meet:** CSD's preferred video conferencing platform that helps connect you during virtual parent teacher conferences.
- **Easy Access:** Join meetings from a web browser on your computer or through the Google Meet app on a phone or tablet.
- No Google Account Needed: You can join a meeting with just a link, without needing a Google account.



HOW DO I JOIN A GOOGLE MEET?



From a Meeting Code

From a Shared Link:

- Click the meeting link (e.g., meet.google.com/abc-defg-hij) shared in an email, message, or posted for you to access.
- Your web browser or the Meet app (If the Meet app is downloaded it will open automatically, if not you will be ask to download the app).
- Click "Ask to join". A teacher or staff member will admit you to the meeting for your scheduled time.

From a Meeting Code:

- Go to **meet.google.com** or open the app.
- Click the "Enter Code"
- Enter the code provided by the teacher (e.g., abc-defg-hij).
- Click "Join".

WHAT FEATURES CAN I USE IN A MEETING?



Microphone: Click to mute or unmute your audio (red with a slash is muted).



Reactions: Send a quick emoji (like or ♥) that will appear on the screen for everyone.



Leave Call: Teacher will remove you from the call when finished.



Camera: Click to show or hide your video (red is hidden).



CC Captions: Turn on live captions to see a written transcript of the conversation.



Participants: See a list of everyone who is in the meeting.



Present Screen: Share your screen or a specific window with those in the meeting.



Raise Hand: Click this to let the host know you have a question or wish to speak without interrupting.



Chat: Open the chat panel to send typed messages to the group.

NEED THE GOOGLE MEET APP? | PRIOR TO YOUR APPOINTMENT:

- Download the free Google Meet app for your mobile device from the <u>Apple</u>
 <u>App Store</u> (Apple) or <u>Google Play Store</u> (Android).
- Once downloaded, you can join with the "join code" without an account.
