 - Hawk Stash is going well. We moved some food into teacher class rooms because some students feel more comfortable talking with their teachers rather than counselors. 3 new microwaves will be coming to the cafeteria soon.
 - We had 6 bands and 3 solos compete at Battle of the Bands in January which is the best turnout we have had so far. The top band and solo act will go to the Region competition in March.
 - We received a National PTA Grant and will put on a Create with Kindness evening event with the funds. The goal is to help students have a safer experience on social platforms. The presenter is Heather Huish who works with Stand4Kind and our Student Club. She will be joined by 2 members of the Canyons Tech Dept - Katie Gebhardt and Jonathan Stewart who will discuss Dealing with Digital Drama. All parents and teens (ages 13-18) are invited. The event will be held in the library on March 25th at 7pm. There will be lots of Hi-tech prizes and great swag given out! We are also inviting Indian Hills and Mount Jordan 8th graders to the event.

- We just finished Freshman PCCRs, and will be starting Sophomore PCCRs and course requests beginning on Wednesday of this week.
 - The ACT is on March 11. Every Junior is registered automatically for the test. Working to get all Juniors an account so they can receive their ACT score via email. Our ACT Prep class will be offered on Saturday, March 7 from 9am to 3pm here at Alta. It costs \$149. Some colleges require ACT but none in Utah. A good ACT score will help them get into a good school.
