Parking at Alta High is a **privilege**, not a right, and may be **revoked for violations** of this contract or school rules. To maintain parking privileges, students and parents/guardians must read and agree to the following terms:

Eligibility & Permits

- **Only 11th and 12th grade students may purchase one \$15 parking permit.** A motorcycle permit is available upon request.
- All fees/fines must be paid before receiving a permit. Extenuating circumstances (e.g., financial hardship) should be discussed with an administrator.
- Students must present a signed contract, driver's license, and vehicle registration to purchase a permit.
- Permits are not transferable to other students or vehicles.

Permit Use

- Permits must be permanently affixed (not taped) to the lower-left corner of the front windshield.
- A permit does not guarantee a parking space. Parking is first come, first served.
- Parking is allowed only in designated student lots on the west side of campus.
- Vehicles must be moved from the Drivers Ed range by 3:00 p.m. or are subject to towing at the owner's expense.

Prohibited Parking Areas

- Faculty Parking Lots (east side of the building)
- Visitor/PAC Parking Lot (west side of the building closest to the main entrance)
- Reserved or handicap parking spots (without an ADA *and* Alta permit)
- Bus zones, red curbs, sidewalks, or lawns

Off-campus parking is not monitored or enforced by Alta High School. Sandy City Police may issue citations for illegal parking off-campus.

Safety & Legal Compliance

- Vehicles must comply with all state laws and be properly registered and maintained.
- Weapons, drugs, alcohol, or stolen property in vehicles are strictly prohibited and will result in school discipline and possible police referral.
- School officials may search vehicles on campus if warranted by law.

Lost or Damaged Permits

- Lost decals will be replaced for a fee. If you misplace your decal, you are responsible to notify the front office and receive a replacement pass. Failure to display a decal will result in a ticket, even if it was only missing for one day.
- Damaged decals or those removed due to windshield replacement may be replaced at no cost if the original is returned.
- A new decal permit will be issued and the old number permit will not be recognized as a valid parking decal.

Consequences for Parking Violations:

- Verbal warnings
- Parking citations
- Booting of the vehicle
- Towing and impoundment (owner's expense)
- Loss of parking privileges

Citations must be paid promptly or the permit will be revoked. Unpaid fines may be sent to collections.
